Because the Governor has signed a death warrant for the execution of Amos Lee King, Jr. at 6:00 p.m. Thursday, January 24, 2002, we direct that all further proceedings in this case be expedited.

The initial brief on the merits shall be served on or before 12:00 noon Friday, January 4, 2002; the answer brief on the merits shall be served on or before 4:00 p.m. Wednesday, January 9, 2002; and the reply brief on the merits shall be served on or before 5:00 p.m. Friday, January 11, 2002.


